

**Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is hereby made and entered into by and between: (1) International Association of Muslim Psychologists; (2) Association of Islamic Psychology (Asosiasi Psikologi Islam); (3) Faculty of Psychology, Universitas Gadjah Mada; (4) Faculty of Psychology and Social Culture (Fakultas Psikologi dan Sosial Budaya), Universitas Islam Indonesia; (5) Faculty of Social and Humaniora Science (Fakultas Ilmu Sosial dan Humaniora), Universitas Islam Negeri Yogyakarta; (6) Faculty of Psychology (Fakultas Psikologi), Universitas Ahmad Dahlan, hereinafter referred to as collaborators.

Collaborators recognize the importance of strengthening cooperation on Conferences, Researches, Teachings, and Community Services of Cultural and Islamic Psychology and are willing to combine their efforts and work together in fostering development of Cultural and Islamic Psychology.

ARTICLE 1

PARTICIPATING INSTITUTIONS

The participating institutions in this memorandum of understanding are:

2. Association of Islamic Psychology (Asosiasi Psikologi Islam) in Yogyakarta, Indonesia, that is represented by the President of Association of Islamic Psychology, Prof. Drs. Subandi, M.A., Ph.D.
3. Faculty of Psychology, Universitas Gadjah Mada in Yogyakarta Indonesia that is represented by the Dean of Faculty of Psychology, Universitas Gadjah Mada, Prof. Dr. Faturochman, M.A.
4. Faculty of Psychology and Social Culture (Fakultas Psikologi dan Sosial Budaya), Universitas Islam Indonesia in Yogyakarta, Indonesia that is represented by the Dean of Faculty of Psychology and Social Culture, Universitas Islam Indonesia, Dr.rer.nat. Arief Fahmie, S.Psi, MA, Psi.

5. Faculty of Social and Humaniora Science (Fakultas Ilmu Sosial dan Humaniora), Universitas Islam Negeri Yogyakarta in Yogyakarta, Indonesia that is represented by the Dean of Faculty of Social and Humaniora Science Universitas Islam Negeri Yogyakarta, Dr. Mochamad Sodik, S.Sos.
6. Faculty of Psychology (Fakultas Psikologi), Universitas Ahmad Dahlan in Yogyakarta, that is represented by the Dean of Faculty of Psychology Universitas Ahmad Dahlan, Drs. Choirul Anam, M.Si.

ARTICLE 2

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

The collaborators agreed to work together in the development of Islamic Psychology, collaboration in research, conferences, teaching, community service related to Cultural and Islamic Psychology. This agreement describes their understanding and commitments to this collaborative effort.

ARTICLE 3

DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement shall be deemed to be effective from the 12th October 2016 and ending 11th October 2019 (in term of 3 years). The scope and duration of the collaboration may be amended and/or extended through the joint agreement to amendments to this agreement.

ARTICLE 4

DECISION-MAKING STRUCTURE & AUTHORITY

All significant decisions regarding the collaboration will require agreement by all collaborative partners. Significant decisions will include decisions regarding eligibility for services provided through collaboration, the nature of the services to be provided, and decisions regarding seeking and using funding to carry out collaboration activities.

ARTICLE 5
LEGAL AND FINANCIAL STRUCTURE

This memorandum of understanding has no legal binding and no direct funding of the collaborative, except for joint activities that will be regulated by separate operational agreement.

ARTICLE 5
ADDITION OF NEW PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATIONS

The collaborators may from time to time recommend the addition of other organizations or governmental entities may be invited to participate in the collaboration. If the invited organizations/entities decide to participate, all the collaborators will amend this collaboration agreement to include all participating organizations, with all participating organizations sharing equally in the rights and responsibilities described in this agreement.

ARTICLE 6
TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

Each participating organization retains the right to withdraw from the collaboration upon giving the other participating organizations at least 30 days notice of its decision to withdraw. The withdrawal of any participating organization from the collaboration shall result in termination of this collaboration agreement. The remaining organizations may choose to enter into a new agreement to guide their continuing work together

ARTICLE 7
EXTENSION AND AMENDMENT OF THIS AGREEMENT

This agreement may be extended or amended only through unanimous agreement. The decision to amend or extend the agreement, and language describing the agreed upon changes, shall be documented in writing, including the date of the amendment/extension, and the signatures of the head of each participating organization.

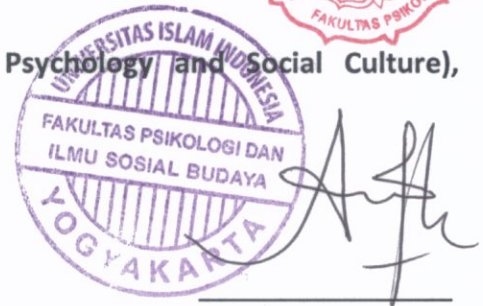

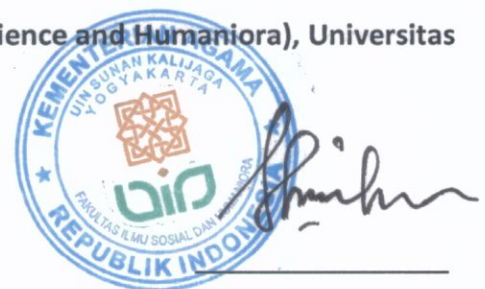
